


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UNIVERSITY MODEL SCHOOL What is a University Model School?

University Model Schooling is a form of education that takes the college schedule and brings it into a K-12 format. Students attend classes at the school building 2-3 days per week, and spend time studying and learning from home on the "home days." This model mimics the college format and helps prepare college-worthy students.

We believe this model best helps equip parents to be the primary influencer in a students life, and gives them opportunities to be involved in their student's education. That's why we have partnered with the National Association Model Schools to become a certified University Model School.

What does this look like for my student?

Students will receive formal instruction in all of the basic, core subject areas when attending GCA. When at home, study days will involve reading, writing, mat, and other projects which are assigned in class and will be turned in for grading on the formal school days. You will not be expected to teach any new material. The classroom teacher will do the teaching, and you will serve as a co-teacher, guide, or coach, depending on your student's age.

New Student Enrollment	\$375	New students must pay the price of \$375/student.
Current Student Re-Enrollment	\$250	Current students pay the re-enrollment fee of \$250/student. Deadline Feb. 29th.


Who is this program for?
